Summer sign-up begins today and the following will walk you through what you can expect.

We are asking summer volunteers to sign up for the following number of shows:

- * 2 "Prime Time" performances
- * 1 Captain Position (besides *West Side Story*)
- * 1 Film
- * 1 *West Side Story* Performance (dates 8/20-8/22)—although this is a community show, we need a large number of ushers for 3 shows, and expect a large turnout.
- * 2 Waitlist shows—NEW this sign up period & optional. This allows you to add your name for up to two more shows that you might like to work.

For Prime Time Performances, please plan to arrive in time for the meeting that will now begin one hour prior to performance time. These meetings usually hold more detail and are taking a bit longer. We appreciate your help and understanding with the change).

For Movies, Meetings will start 45 minutes prior to performance time.
